Draft Minutes Budget and Personnel Committee Meeting

1. Call to Order:

3. Approve the Draft Minutes of the June 7, 2022 Meeting:

Director Morton made a motion to approve the minutes of June 7, 2022. President Shriner seconded the motion. The minutes were approved by a vote of 2-Ayes (Morton, Shriner), 0-Noes, and 0-Absent.

4. Discuss the Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Policy:

Ms. Gill reviewed the Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Policy (DEI) included in the packet. Mr. Scherzinger stated that this policy was from the Water Education Foundation and eventually would be incorporated into the Employee Handbook. He suggested the Committee members either make edits during this meeting or edit it and send it back for staff to pull together and bring back to another meeting.
