Agenda Title: Consider Adoption of Resolution No. 2011-09 to Approve a Line of Credit

Agreement with California American Water Company

Detailed Description: The Board of Directors is requested to consider adoption of Resolution No. 2011-09 to approve a line of credit agreement with California American Water Company (CAW). On February 24, 2010, the Board adopted Resolution No. 2010-12 to approve a reimbursement agreement with CAW which provided a mechanism for reimbursement from CAW to the MCWD and Monterey County Water Resources Agency (the Public Agencies) for funds expended by the Public Agencies on the Regional Desalination Project (the Project). Under the reimbursement agreement, development costs for the Project were reimbursed until the earlier of (a) the date the Public Agencies obtain proceeds of financing for the Project sufficient to both meet the Public Agencies' ongoing direct project-related costs and commence repayment to CAW of funds reimbursed under this agreement, or (b) December 31, 2010. The reimbursement agreement has now expired.

On April 5, 2010, the Board adopted Resolution No. 2010-20 that approved MCWD's participation in the Project pursuant to the Water Purchase Agreement (WPA) and the Settlement Agreement, contingent on final approval from the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC). The effective date of the WPA shall be January 12, 2011 based on CPUC approval of the Project on December 2, 2010, and provided that each of the Public Agencies and CAW satisfies the conditions precedent set forth in Article 25 of the WPA by January 12, 2011. Pursuant to the terms of Sections 7.1(c)(i) and (ii) of the WPA, CAW shall make available to each of the Public Agencies a revolving credit facility up to an aggregate total of \$8,000,000 as a source of short term loans for the purpose of managing financial liquidity needs in connection with the Project.

MCWD will incur costs associated with securing permits and obtaining financing for the Project. In order to avoid delaying work on the Project or impacting MCWD's finances, staff recommends that the Board approve the line of credit from CAW. Once financing is obtained for the Project, proceeds from the financing will pay in full the line of credit from CAW.

WHEREAS, the Regional Desalination Project was approved by the California Public Utilities Commission on December 2, 2010; and,

WHEREAS, a short-term financing mechanism is needed in order for the Regional Desalination Project to keep moving forward without impacting the District's finances.
