Water demands are based upon:

- Year 2009 water use (existing), plus
- FORA FY10/11 CIP projection, with input from the jurisdictions, and
- Water demand rates as used in the project Water Supply Assessment, or
- District standard demand rates, where a WSA was not previously prepared

Existing Water Supplies


- Salinas Valley Groundwater
 - Central Marina 3,020 acre-feet/year (AFY)
 - Ord Community 6,600 AFY
 - 1,577 AFY retained by US Army
 - 5,023 AFY allocated by FORA among the jurisdictions
- MCWD Pilot Desalination Plant
 - 300 AFY contracted to Marina Project Group








