



Please Suspend Your Irrigation!

More rain is expected to arrive tonight and later this week. It is important to take action today to stop unnecessary watering.

Follow the checklist below to make sure you're doing your part to reduce water waste:

- Turn off your automatic irrigation controller and delay any planned manual irrigation
- Remember that irrigation is not permitted during and 48 hours after a rainfall event
- If weather does clear and watering is again required, water manually and only as needed until Spring
- If you must use automatic irrigation, be sure to use a rain shut off switch. Make sure it is operable and will suspend watering for at least two days
- In the event of a power outage, make sure your irrigation controller has not re-programmed to a default mode of watering every day
- Delay turning your irrigation controller back on again until automatic scheduling of irrigation events is warranted
