



## Please Suspend Your Irrigation!

More rain is expected to arrive tonight and early next week. It is important to take action today to stop unnecessary watering.

To make sure you are doing your part to reduce irrigation water waste follow these easy steps:

- Turn off your automatic irrigation controller and delay any planned manual irrigation
- Remember that irrigation is not necessary during and 48 hours after a rainfall event
- If weather does clear and watering is again required, water manually and only as needed until Spring
- Be sure to use a rain shut-off switch. Make sure it is operable and will suspend watering for at least two days
- In the event of a power outage, check to make sure your irrigation controller has not been re-programmed to a default mode of watering every day
- Delay turning your irrigation controller back on again until automatic scheduling of irrigation events is warranted
