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Marina Coast Water District to Begin Water Main Replacement on California Avenue

Marina Coast Water District (MCWD) will soon begin construction on the California Avenue Water Main Upsizing and Replacement Project to improve water delivery and system reliability within the City of Marina. The project will take place along California Avenue, between Patton Parkway and Reindollar Avenue.

Project Overview: The water main upgrade will involve installing approximately 1,300 linear feet of new water pipeline. This project is part of the District's ongoing investment in improving water infrastructure and is designed to:

- Increase water delivery capacity
- Enhance system reliability
- Support long-term water service to the Central Marina area
- Ensure dependable water service for years to come

This work is part of a broader District effort to invest \$10 million annually in upgrading and maintaining essential water, sewer, and recycled water systems across the community.

Construction Schedule. Work is planned to begin on March 16 and is expected to be completed by mid-to-late May. Project construction will occur Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., with roadway construction signs placed approximately one week prior to the start of work to provide advance notice to residents and drivers.

Traffic and Access Impacts. Construction will require temporary traffic control measures and detour routes to complete the work. Drivers should expect minor delays during certain active work hours and are encouraged to use alternate routes when possible. Traffic will be directed through or around the work zone, and all work will comply with City of Marina encroachment permit requirements.

Homes along California Avenue are back-facing, so there will be minimal disruption to driveways. However, brief, temporary intersection restrictions may occur at Patton Parkway and Reindollar Avenue during pipeline tie-in work. Advance notice will be provided if this happens. Customers along the construction route will receive door hanger updates before construction begins.

Noise and Dust Control. Crews will follow all City of Marina requirements for dust and noise control during construction. Dust suppression measures will be used, and all work will be conducted during permitted hours to minimize disruptions to the community.

Safety Reminders. The safety of the community and construction crews is a top priority. Residents and motorists are reminded to: Reduce speed in work zones, follow posted signage, and obey flaggers and

traffic control measures.

MCWD appreciates the community's patience as this essential project is completed. These improvements will help ensure the continued reliability and quality of water service for years to come.
