## 30+ Days Left to Enroll in the Water & Sewer Assistance Program.

California's Low Income Household Water Assistance Program (LIHWAP) will remain open through March 31, 2024.

Marina, CA — With just 30+ days left to sign up, Marina Coast Water District is encouraging lowincome customers to apply for help paying their current or past-due water and sewer bills through the Low-Income Household Water Assistance Program (LIHWAP). **Customers have until March 31**, **2024**, to apply.

**Eligible households should apply now while funds last.** "There's still time for low-income households to find relief from water and sewer costs through LIHWAP," said Barbara Montanti, Customer Service / Billing Supervisor for Marina Coast Water District. "Because funding is limited and assistance is granted on a first-come, first-served basis, we encourage residents to apply now and seize this opportunity for financial assistance."

Through LIHWAP, thousands of low-income residents in Monterey have already received substantial financial support, addressing both current and overdue bills.

**Many Customers Already Qualify.** Households with an income below 60 percent of the state median income, such as \$103,856 for a family of four, and households that are already participating in CalFresh, CalWORKs, or the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) are eligible for LIHWAP.
